

PHDS DRESS CODE

A student's dress and general appearance do much to influence a positive attitude toward school and help to generate respect for the learning environment. As a result, we ask all parents to assist us in maintaining proper dress for our students.

BOYS

TOPS:

Grades 1–5

- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid long-sleeve shirt
- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid short-sleeve shirt with at least two buttons or a collar
- No logos, words, graphics, or insignia may appear on the outside of the shirt.

Grades 6–8

- Any solid-colored polo shirt
- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid button-down shirt with a collar
- No logos, words, graphics, or insignia may appear on the outside of the shirt

PANTS:

- Navy or black solid pants or slacks
- No sweatpants, jeans, denim, corduroy, or cargo pants
- No shorts

OTHER:

- *Tzitzis* and *yarmulkes* must be worn at all times.
- Baseball caps are not appropriate for the classroom.
- Only closed shoes or sneakers may be worn. Crocs are not to be worn to school.
- Socks must be worn at all times.

GIRLS

TOPS:

Grades 1–3

- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid three-quarter or long-sleeve shirt
- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid short-sleeve shirt with at least two buttons or a collar
- No logos, words, graphics, or insignia may appear on the outside of the shirt

Grades 4–5

- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid three-quarter length or long-sleeve shirt
- No logos, words, graphics, or insignia may appear on the outside of the shirt

Grades 6–8

- Any solid-colored polo shirt
- Any solid, striped, checkered, or plaid button-down shirt with a collar
- No logos, words, graphics, or insignia may appear on the outside of the shirt
- Three-quarter length or long sleeve

SKIRTS:

- Solid black or navy jumpers or skirts. Skirt styles must be wider at the hem than at the waist, for example, A-line or pleated.
- No denim, corduroy, sweatshirt, pleather, or sweater knit
- No pencil skirts, bubble skirts, or high/low hems
- Skirts should cover the knee while standing, sitting, and walking.
- Skirts should not be longer than the ankle bone.

OTHER:

- Only closed shoes or sneakers may be worn. Crocs are not to be worn to school.
- Socks or tights must be worn at all times.
- Leggings may only be worn if they are not visible under the skirt or jumper.
- Makeup is inappropriate for school and jewelry should be minimal.
- Only a single earring is allowed in each ear. Hair may not be dyed or colored.

SWEATERS/EXTRA LAYER (Boys and Girls):

Grades 1–5

- PHDS sweatshirt (hoods may not be worn on students' heads within the school building)
- Any solid-color sweater or sweatshirt of any style (hood may not be worn on students' heads within the school building)
- Other than the school logo there may be no logos, words, graphics, or insignia on the outside of the sweater/sweatshirt

Grades 6–8

- PHDS sweatshirt (hoods may not be worn on students' heads within the school building)
- Black, navy, or gray zip-up or button cardigan sweater or sweatshirt with or without a hood (hoods may not be worn on students' heads within the school building)
- No logos, words, graphics, or insignia may appear on the outside of the sweater/sweatshirt other than the PHDS sweatshirt
- Middle-school boys may also wear a black, navy, or gray suit jacket as a second layer for *davening*.

PRESCHOOL

Preschool students, both boys and girls, may wear pants, shorts in warm weather, and T-shirts. Girls may also wear skirts, dresses, or jumpers.

Please send your child to school in comfortable, casual clothing that can be easily put on and taken off in the bathroom. Clothing should be appropriate for messy art activities.
